Settling in Procedure

We are keen that children feel safe and happy in the absence of their parents/carers and to develop positive relationships with their key-person and other adults in the room. Our partnership with parents is achieved by:

1. Explaining how our setting operates and how we aim to achieve the EYFS framework by providing a safe learning environment to promote all areas of development.
2. Encouraging parents to visit our setting with their children in the weeks before an admission is planned.
3. Introduce flexible admission procedures, if appropriate, to meet the needs of individual families and children.
4. We reassure and support parents/carers whose children seem to be taking a long time to settle into the nursery by encouraging parents/carers to separate for brief periods at first and building up to longer absences.
